Killarney – Galway City 2h30m-3h 210km

May 12 Galway City

Travel to the breathtaking Cliffs of Moher. Walk through picturesque countryside along the cliffs. Opt for a night out at the local pub. Spend a few hours following the Wild Atlantic Way trail from Doolin to the Cliffs of Moher. Stroll leisurely along the path, soaking in the views. Opt for a picnic along the way.

Private Vehicle

Galway City – Cliffs of Moher 1h30m-2h 76km

Set off on a half-day hike along the cliffs, with a maximum height of 214m (702 ft) above the Atlantic. Take in the incredible views as you trek along the cliff's edge. Visit the tower near the midpoint and look out into the sea beyond. This is a great spot to take some fantastic photos of the panoramic view.

May 14 Belfast

Stop at the Giant's Causeway and marvel at the natural phenomenon of its volcanic columns. Giant's Causeway is a UNESCO World Heritage site and one of the most stunning coastlines in Europe. This area is known for its unique, polygonal column rock formations that were created by a volcanic eruption 60 million years ago.



Old Bushmills tour 1h-1h30m

At 400 years, Old Bushmills Distillery is the oldest working distillery in Ireland. The

distillery believes the secret to good whiskey is crafting the spirit in small batches; taste the difference yourself as you indulge in a whiskey tasting.
